

## North Crawley Parish Neighbourhood Plan Steering Group Update

- ❖ There has been no Steering group meeting since lockdown, so there are no minutes
- ❖ The government has now gone further than its advice of 16th March, and positively instructed people to stay at home in all circumstances, except for a handful of unavoidable circumstances
- ❖ The Village Hall bookings have been cancelled for the foreseeable future
- ❖ The SG message to the village was posted on the PC noticeboard, on Gog Lane and other places around the village, as well as being emailed out with the minutes of the week before, on 21/03/2020. Some positive feedback received by E-mail same day
- ❖ Meetings that have taken place with 3 landowners have provided a starting point for some potential modelling. However, this is not yet at a stage where plans can be made public
- ❖ Discussions with landowners will continue. The subcommittee will determine the best mode for discussion (i.e. telephone or one of the many video conferencing apps), and how best to divide up the discussions (i.e. two subcommittee members likely to be sufficient for initial contact)
- ❖ Steering Group Updates will appear on the Parish Council noticeboard and by the post box on Gog Lane, as required, they will also be posted electronically on Facebook, on the Parish Council website and to those on the email distribution list
- ❖ There will also be comment from the Steering Group in the Monthly SCAN magazine
