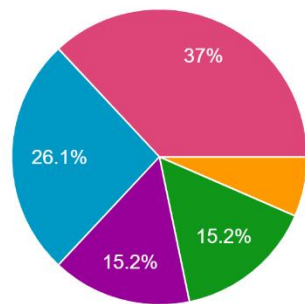

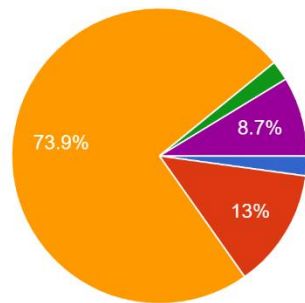

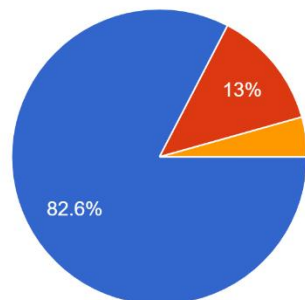

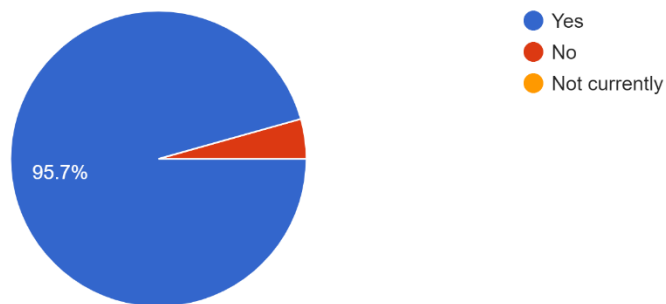

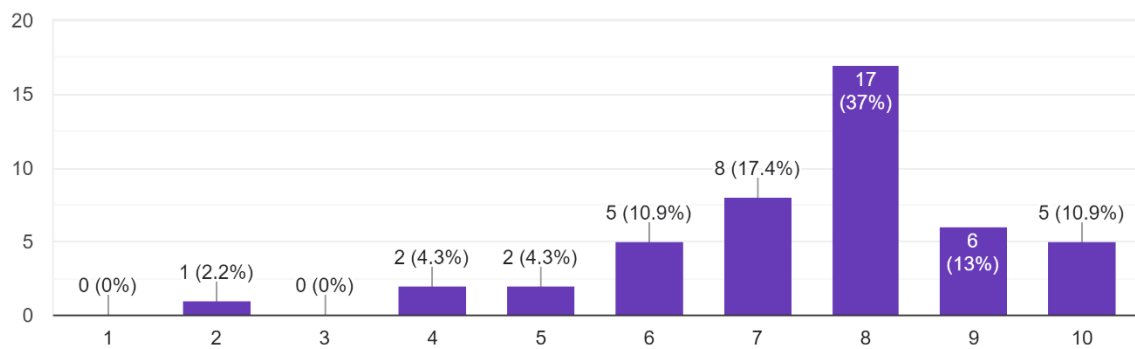
## Do you use the internet?

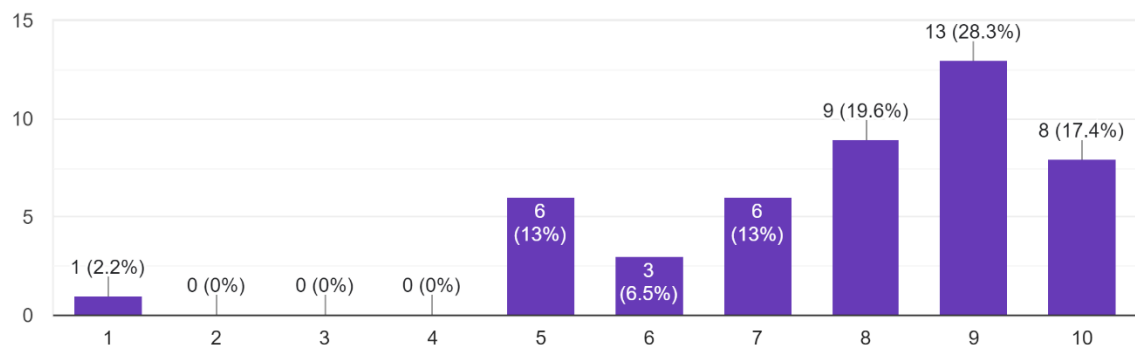
## Do you think the Parish Council does a good job?

## Do you understand what the Parish Council's role is in the Parish?

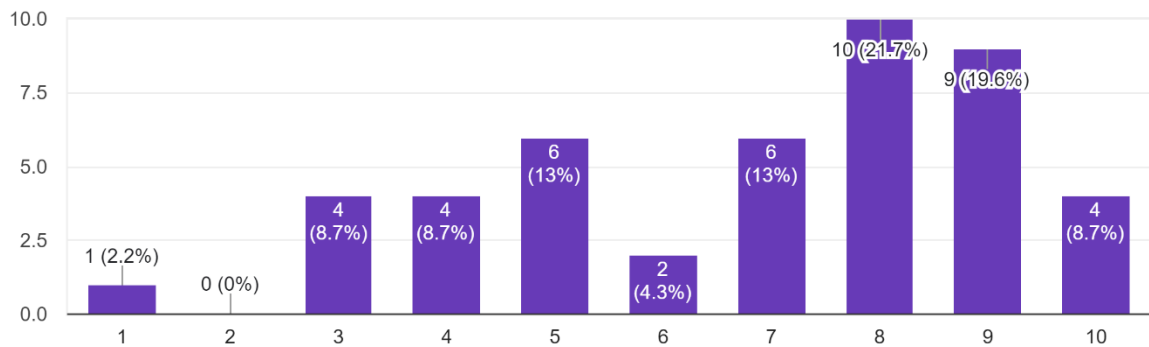

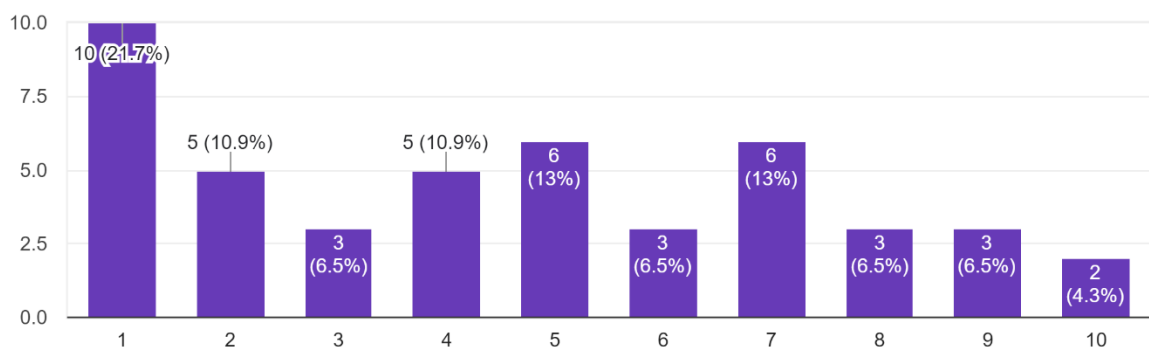
Do you think the Parish Council currently communicate enough about its work?

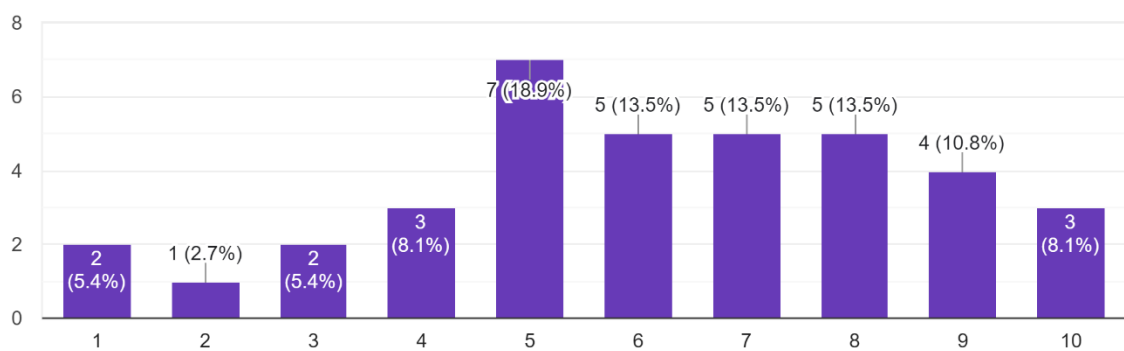
Do you use or consult the Parish Council website?

If you have used it, is the Parish Council website easy to use?

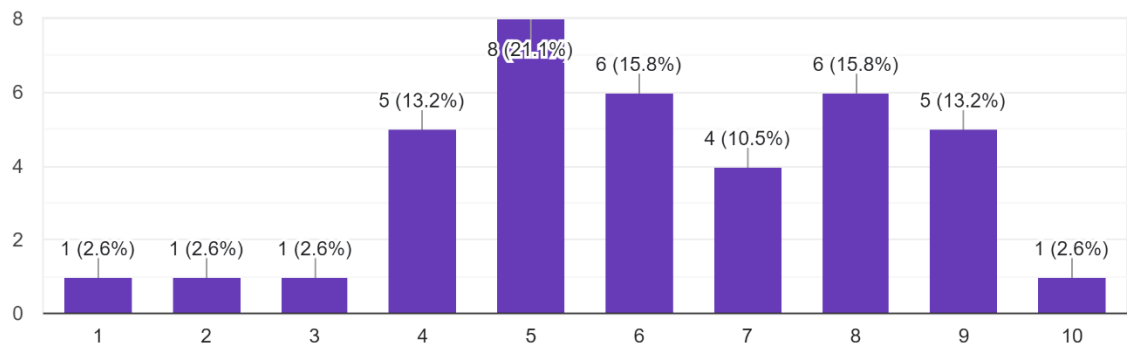

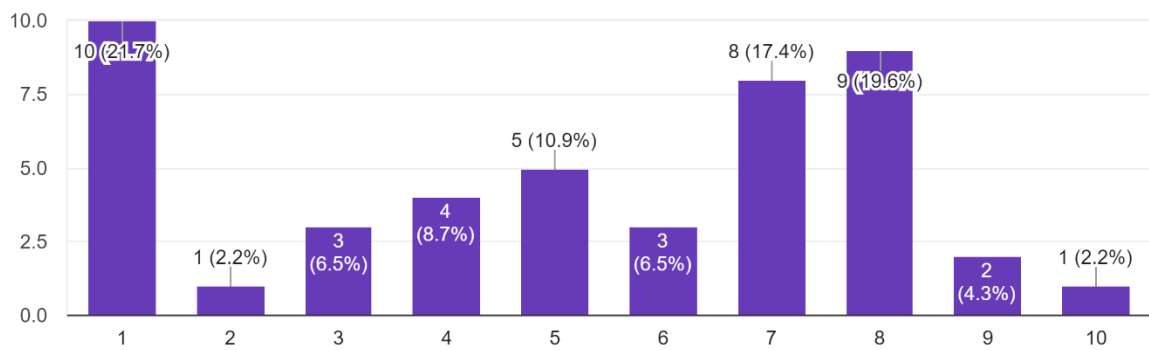
If you have used it, Is the Parish Council website interesting and relevant?

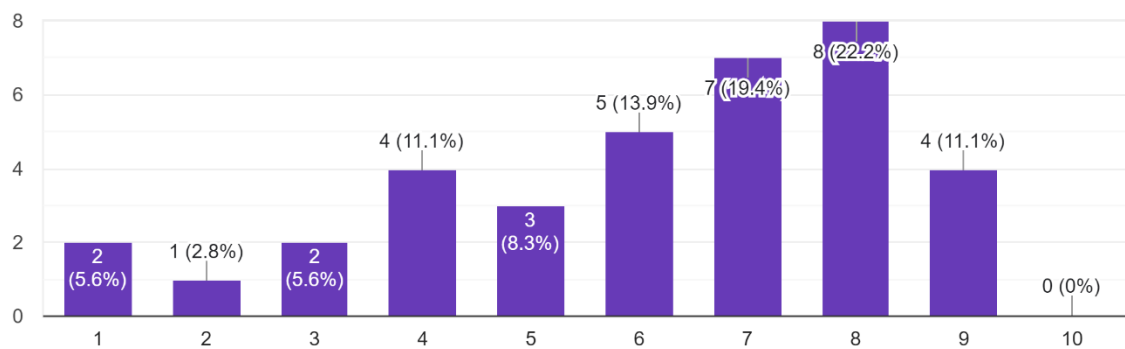
Do you view the Parish Council Facebook page?

If you have used the Facebook page, do you find it interesting and relevant?

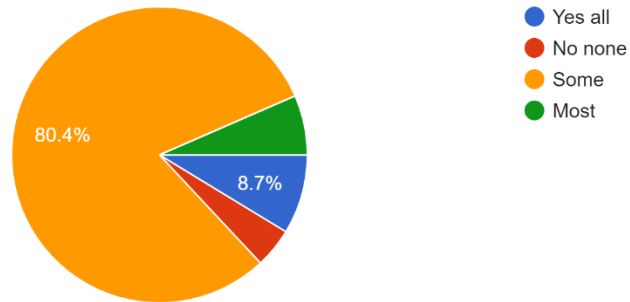

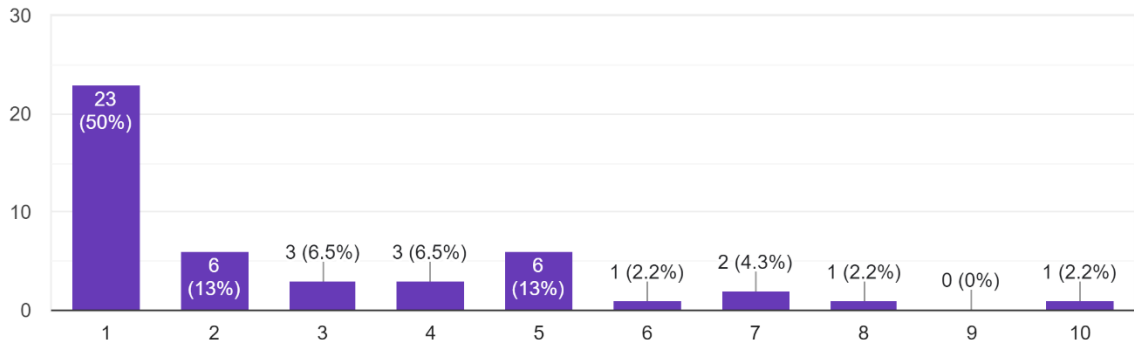
Do you know who the Councillors are on the Parish Council?

Would you consider joining the Parish Council?

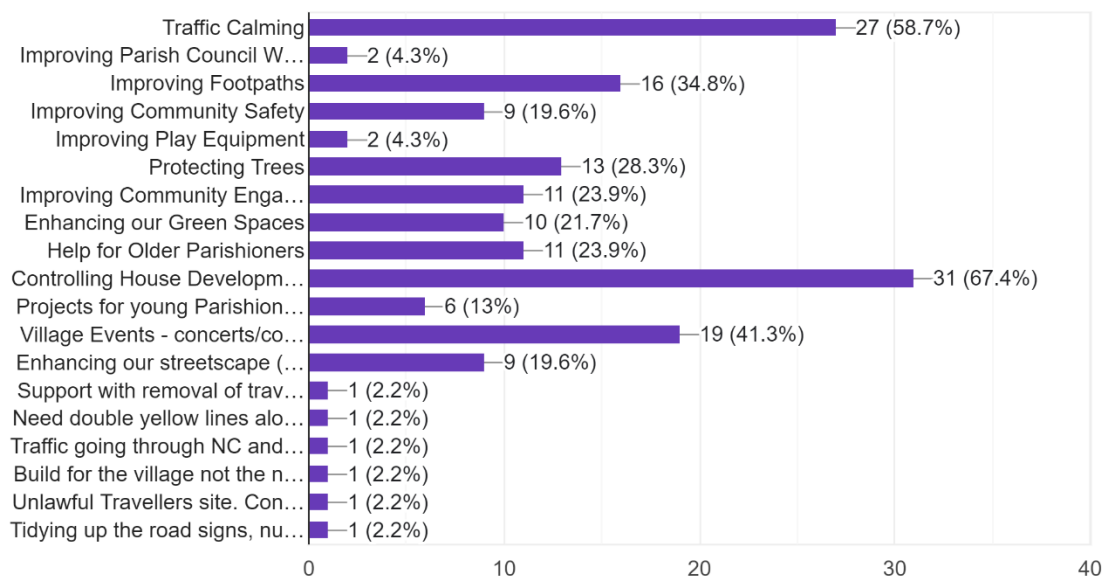

### General comments received:

- I feel the job being done by the council is ok I fear some councillors don't fully know the audience or the north Crawley village way of life some are also appalling and rude especially one man who lives on the outskirts of the village Milton Keynes side
- Some things come across and presented to us in a way that is more for personal gratification and praise to try and make the parish councillor look good rather than the good work they are implementing.
- From the shop to folly lane there should be double yellow lines. At present this creates a dangerous crossing area for the children and parents going to school. It's an accident waiting to happen.
- Need more village bins in prominent places
- better protection for road crossings, more speed signage and stop HGV driving through the village
- Cars parked in the village. Nightmare to get through as no one stops and too many cars parked all the way up, no safe passing points

Smoking in the children's play area and bus shelter all from these persons. I am also aware of them spitting all over the bench in Nixey's Walk. (This has been reported to TVP). Is this something that the Parish Council discuss and maybe approach The Cock management?
- We don't have a traffic speed problem in the village - we have a small traffic volume issue twice a day in the week. Replacing the lollipop lady should be a priority.....it's dangerous when the school buses are there
- We live in Pound Lane and had no idea there had been a survey! Read it in Scan. Have completed it even though it's past the deadline.
- New scheme will mean there are too many bins
- Why can't the speed limit be reduced to the far side of Little Crawley? the other roads out of NC are limited but the National Limit applies after Kilpin Green even though Chicheley Rd is narrower and has more bends and less visibility for oncoming vehicles.
- Concerned about all the bins
- Particularly concerned about the increased volume of traffic passing through the High St. I'm particularly concerned about future provision to accommodate the increased flows of traffic via the proposed Marshall's development and the considerable increase in housing in Newport Pagnell.
